What will participation in SUE Exchange involve?

- Invitation to meetings of the SUE Exchange, anticipated as around twice yearly. These will include input from invited experts and sessions to enable attendees to learn from each other and to exchange ideas.
- Knowledge Exchange experience and advice from other invited contributors
- Access to expert guidance on dissemination and knowledge exchange from external practitioners and trainers
- Information about sources of support and funding for Knowledge Exchange
- An opportunity to showcase successful work to others in SUE and to EPSRC
- Receiving occasional email information about funding and other support for KE
- Other activities and benefits as proposed by members of the SUE Exchange
